School Hot Lunches for Term 2 and 3:

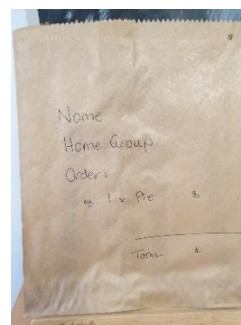
We will be offering pies, pasties, sausage rolls, party pies and a gluten free option for Term 2 and 3 for Friday lunches.
