Casual Clothes Day – Thursday 8th August:

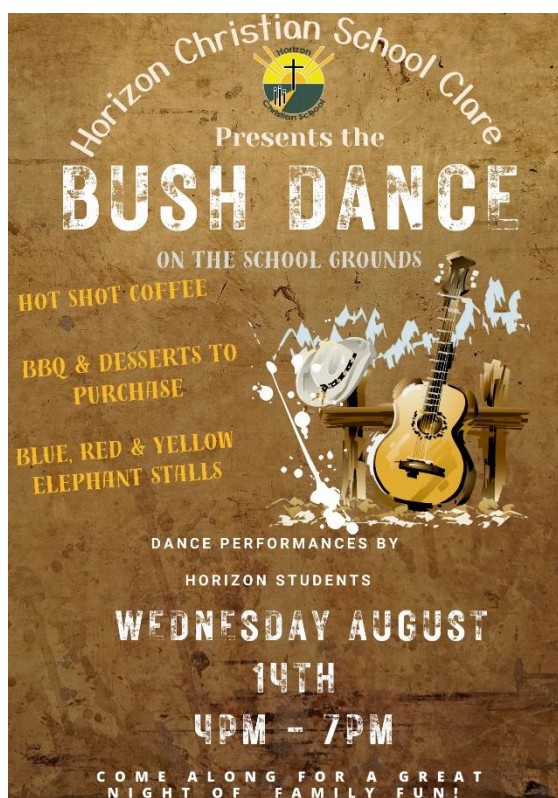
