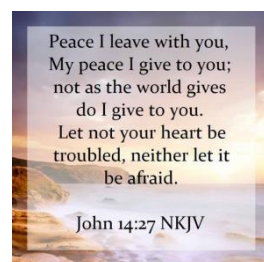
Parent/ Teacher Interviews – Term 4:
