In Week 1 our Year 8 students undertook an educational tour of Canberra. Students were given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. Our students visited Government House, Parliament House, the Australian War Memorial, the High Court, National Museum of Australia, National Gallery of Australia, Australian Institute of Sport, Questacon, Canberra Deep Space Centre, the National Botanic Gardens and many more amazing locations.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$135.00 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.
