25km/h speed limit applies – A reminder from SAPOL:

- Between school crossing (koala crossing) when the lights are flashing as indicated by a Children's Crossing sign.
- When a child is within a school zone, which is formed between a school zone sign and end school zone sign. This applies whenever a child is on the road, footpath, median strip, or even on a bicycle including outside of school hours. (A 'child' includes a student of any age wearing a school uniform.)
- You must not exceed 25 km/h when passing, in either direction, a school bus that has stopped for the purpose of setting down or picking up children.
